

Alabama State Board of Prosthetists and Orthotists

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Important Reminder

Mastectomy Fitters and O & P Facilities, that only provide orthotic and prosthetic services, are no longer required to be licensed by the Home Medical Equipment Services Providers Board (HME) as a provider.

If you decide not to renew your HME provider license for this upcoming year, you will likely receive a letter from the HME Board indicating that your license has expired and that the HME Board will be notifying the National Suppliers Clearing House and Alabama Medicaid.

In order to prevent potential problems with third party payors it is **VERY IMPORTANT** that you do the following:

Once you have received the letter from HME send an email or letter to HME stating “*Name of company* did not renew its HME provider license due to a change in interpretation in the applicable law and that an HME provider license is no longer required for my business”. You will then ask HME to send a letter to the third party payors they notified advising them of this change. You will also want to ask HME to send a copy of the notice they sent to third party payors for your records.
